PRIVILEGES AT UT SOUTHWESTERN MEDICAL CENTER FOR VOLUNTEER FACULTY

Library and parking privileges are available to all Volunteer Faculty members.

Library Privileges

Volunteer Faculty are eligible for the following Library services:

- 1. Use of the Library's extensive collections on-campus, which requires a UTSW identification badge. This includes:
 - Access to the Library's online collection, one of the most extensive online collections in the state of Texas.
 - Access to archives, rare books, and history of medicine collection.
 - 24/7 UTSW ID badge access to computers and study rooms at both Library locations.
- 2. Reference assistance.
- 3. Online searches.
- 4. Fee-based Interlibrary Loan services.
- 5. Eligibility to register for Library classes.

NOTE: The Library does <u>not</u> issue UTSW identification badges or grant remote access to Library resources. Volunteer Faculty should contact their sponsoring department to obtain a UTSW identification badge and network access.
